

We are proud and privileged to provide this national caliber volleyball championship event in the Chicago land area! We are most excited that there is no qualifying for our event—it is available to all teams, whether you belong to any organization or not, on a first come, first serve basis. #### **COMPETITION VENUE:**

We are pleased to return to Chicago's Lakefront Navy Pier again for our 15<sup>th</sup> year due to popular demand! It's a world class atmosphere with a multitude of events happening—beautifully located out on Lake Michigan amidst views that are world famous. The renovations to Navy Pier recently make it even more enticing.

#### **COMPETITION FORMAT:**

On Friday, Saturday, and Sunday June 11-12-13, 2921 competition will be for girls 13u-18u in a three-day format with pool play days one and two and elimination brackets day three. Single elimination begins with bracket play on day three where you will compete until eliminated or win the championship of your division! Entry fee \$750

PLEASE NOTE: In the event of a late drop or cancellation that is unforeseeable, we may have to adjust pools to "AUTO three", which means, 3 sets against other the two teams, (6 sets total) when a fourth team in the pool drops late. This is not our desirable format, but occasionally a late drop occurs and no other option exists.

June 14-15, 2021 is a two-day format for all boys 12u-14u and girls 12u,13u, 14u and combined 16/15u wishing a two-day format. Day one is pool play and day two is bracket elimination play. Entry fee is \$475

All pool play days use the format of "wave play" in the preliminary rounds of competition. <u>You cannot choose the wave</u> and they will not be announced until about two-three weeks before the event. Waves will depend on the current COVID 19 capacity rules et by

the city of Chicago, Cook County, the state of Illinois and Navy Pier. Formats could range from two waves as always used in the past to four sessions of ¼ the field in each session. Waves will be posted on our website and first match times will be announced no later than 1 week before the competition at:

On the final day of competition in each session, all teams must be prepared for an 7:30 am start as bracket play depends on seeding and results from preliminary rounds.

#### **CONVENTION CENTER RULES:**

- All guests can be driven up onto Navy Pier and dropped off, regardless of whether you choose to park or not—the best drop off point is the East or West Entrance drop off down the North Side of the Pier—look at the map at <a href="http://www.navypier.com/pdf/PierMap.pdf">http://www.navypier.com/pdf/PierMap.pdf</a> Follow the signs to "Festival Hall"
- Food and drink are allowed in the Hall. Garbage must be placed in containers
  throughout the Hall to make an enjoyable experience for all—teams who do not clean
  their bench areas after each match will incur a 10-point penalty on their next
  match/first game (both teams will the incur the penalty as it is their responsibility to
  clean both bench areas!) Eating or drinking at the score tables will incur the same
  penalty as above
- <u>COOLERS</u> are not permitted in the Convention Center. There are plenty of park areas
  along Lake Michigan adjacent to the Convention Center so leave your coolers in your
  cars and picnic outside. The view is spectacular! Convention Center Security will
  confiscate any coolers brought into the hall for safety reasons.
- SMOKING is not permitted in the Halls—smokers will have to check for designated areas where smoking is allowed.
- NO OUTSIDE CHAIRS ARE PERMITTED TO BE BROUGHT IN PER CHICAGO FIRE
  MARSHAL CODE. Chairs are provided, and seating areas are limited to spaces the event
  staff feels safe to place. Generally, seating is behind the end lines and not permitted
  between the courts but on a few courts, it may be opposite...check at each court and
  referees will police this! Officials have the right to request spectators be moved or to
  eject unruly fans.
- ALCOHOL is not permitted in the Hall of competition per USA Volleyball Rule book

#### **PARKING:**

- We highly encourage the use of vans and car-pooling to save on parking costs.
   We will pass on any discounts in the future if any are available
- Navy Pier parking rates and advance parking sales will be sent as soon as they are made available for 2021
- Also consider parking apps like Spot Hero, Panda Parking, etc.

#### **EVENT SCHEDULE:**

- All teams, regardless of session may check in at the Lobby leading into FESTIVAL HALL ON NAVY PIER on Thursday, June 10th from 10:00 am until 6:00pm check in entails verifying your roster, making roster changes, receiving final schedules which could include late changes, drops, etc., picking up team credentials to enter the venue, picking up reserved guest registration bands, etc..... Our staff will be on hand to answer any questions you may have. IT IS NOT MANDATORY TO CHECK IN JUNE 10<sup>TH</sup>—YOU CAN CHECK IN BEGINNING AT 6:15 AM FRIDAY, JUNE 11<sup>TH</sup> BEFORE PLAY BEGINS! However-if you choose to check in Thursday, June 10, and you are not staying except to check in---have someone drop you off at the East area turnaround guest drop off and come back for you to avoid parking charges!
- Teams playing June 14-15 can check in Thursday, June 10 from 10am until 6pm, Friday, June 11 from 8:00am until 6:00pm, or beginning Sunday, June 13 at 10:00am-4pm or the day you play Monday, June 14 starting at 6:15 am.
- No team can compete without checking in or can enter the hall without their credentials that coaches receive at check-in
- One coach/club director / team rep can check in all teams if necessary!
- Please report to tournament check-in for lost credentials

#### APPLICATION PROCEDURES/ENTRY FEES:

- Entries are accepted on a first come, first serve basis...there is no qualifying for this event and it is open to all levels of play
- There are a total maximum number of teams we can accept in each division
   ...so enter early...we will send confirmation as soon as we process your team
   registration fees
- Coaches will need to hand carry and turn in at check in JVA waiver forms for all players and staff
- Entry Fees are \$750 for the three-day event June 11-12-13- and \$475 for the two-day event June 14-15-which can be paid with a Credit Card on AES at www.advancedeventsystems.com or mailed with a check
- Full Entry Registration Fee must be included with entry form to be a valid entry that is confirmed *in order of arrival* in our office

#### **ADMISSION/TOURNAMENT PASSES:**

- FREE Event credentials are provided for a roster maximum of 12 players and two coaches for each team.... Club directors attending but not coaching must indicate themselves only <u>once on one team roster—do not list your name</u> multiple times on other team rosters in your club
- There are <u>no chaperone</u> passes issued—only credentials to players and coaches listed on the roster. Any personnel caught giving their credential for another person illegally using it to enter the hall will be ejected from further participation in the tournament

#### **GUEST REGISTRATION FEES:**

At this time, we do not know how many guests will be allowed depending on the current, if any COVID 19 capacity restriction ARE IN EFFECT. If restrictions remain, we are SELLING guest passes In ADVANCE only THRU THE TEAMS, WITH THE CAPACITY OF 20 GUEST PASSES MAXIMUM TO BE AVAILABLE FOR PURCHASE FROM EACH TEAM. TEAMS NOT PURCHASING THE FULL 20 PASSES PER TEAM FOR GUESTS WILL ALLOW REMAINDERS TO BE OFFERED TO OTHER TEAMS WHO NEED MORE.

#### THE ASICS VOLLEYBALL CHAMPIONSHIPS IS A PRIVATE EVENT:

- Participation in or attendance at the ASICS CHAMPIONSHIPS NAVY PIER is solely by permission from the Event. The Event and Navy Pier Security may revoke that permission at any time, for any reason. All attendees, including players, coaches, officials, and guests must register and must wear their entry credential at all times. Entry credentials may not be shared with or transferred to any other person. By registering, the participant or attendee agrees to these stipulations and all Code of Conduct Rules: violators will be ejected from the event for its duration
- Personal chairs are not allowed in Navy Pier, Seating is provided at each court for spectators. Outside Food and drink is allowed in—however, no coolers allowed in Festival Hall—keep in your cars
- Weapons of all kinds and ammunition are prohibited, both open carry and concealed carry.
- Smoking and smoking devices are prohibited.
- Alcoholic beverages are prohibited inside Festival Hall.
- Illegal drugs and illegal use of any drugs are prohibited in the building.

#### **GUEST CODE OF CONDUCT:**

We have adopted the implementation of the USA Volleyball Code of Conduct and any guest or participant violating any of these rules are subject to permanent dismissal from the venue.

- I WILL abide by the official rules of USA Volleyball and JVA.
- I WILL display good sportsmanship at all times.
- I WILL encourage my child and his/her team, regardless of the outcome on the court.
- I WILL educate myself on the unique rules of this facility.
- I WILL honor the rules of the host and the host facility.
- I WILL generate goodwill by being polite and respectful to those around me at this event.
- I WILL redirect any negative comments from others to the respective Event Director
- I WILL direct all concerns regarding officials to the Head Coach for my team as opposed to -contacting the Head Official directly.
- I WILL immediately notify the Event Director and/or Program Administrator in the event that I witness any illegal activity.
- I WILL support the policies and guidelines of the team/club that I represent.
- I WILL acknowledge effort and good performance, remembering that all of the players are amateur athletes.
- I WILL model exemplary spectator behavior while attending this event.
- I WILL respect the history and tradition of the sport of volleyball by being a good ambassador.
- I WILL NOT harass or intimidate the officials.
- I WILL NOT coach my child from the bleachers and/or sidelines.
- I WILL NOT criticize my child's coach or his/her teammates.
- I WILL NOT bring and/or carry any firearms into any venue.

#### I WILL ABIDE BY ANY COVID-19 RESTRICTIONS IN PLACE, IF ANY DURING EVENT

#### **REFUND POLICY:**

- Teams withdrawing from the tournament after entering and being accepted, who withdraw BY WRITTEN NOTIFCATION, prior to a deadline of May 1, 2020 will receive a 50% refund of entry fee
- Teams withdrawing after May 1 WILL NOT RECEIVE A REFUND UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES!
- If COVID-19 causes cancellation of event, full 100% will be refunded of payments made except prior credits, if any from the 2019 cancellation



#### FORCE MAJEURE:

• Since our costs are fixed for the budget of running this event, in the event a match or matches must be cancelled for circumstances out of our control—no refunds can be granted, and we will impose the legal term of force majeurethis can be power/facility outages, pandemic or health concerns, terrorism threats, etc.

#### WHAT TO BRING:

Each coach should hand carry and have in his/her possession the following items in case of accident or age dispute:

- Players medical release forms in case of injury (keep in your possession)
- JVA signed Waiver form for all players and staff (turn in at check in)
- Practice balls for warm up—we do not provide
- First Aid kit
- Any Masks, sanitizers, wipes, etc. Or COVID 19 protection equipment IF required

#### **TEAM ROSTERS:**

- The team roster is limited to 15 players and 2 coaches. Only those
  persons, whose names are listed on the roster, may sit on the player's
  bench during competition. Only those persons, whose names are listed
  on the OFFICIAL ROSTER FORM, will be issued a Championships
  Credential, which allows free admission into the venue for all 5 days.
  NO EXCEPTIONS!
- Rosters MUST be submitted in AES or if that is not possible via email to Midwestjvb@gmail.com
- DEADLINE FOR INITIAL ROSTER SUBMISSION is June 1, 2021

#### **ROSTER CHANGES:**

• Changes after June 1st must be done at tournament check in at Navy Pier Registration Desk outside FESTIVAL HALL/you may add or delete

#### WAIVERS

 JVA accepts players up to one year past birthday age deadlines published by USAV—simply email us at <a href="midwetjvb@gmail.com">midwetjvb@gmail.com</a> with players name and team and we will check the box for waiver

#### **RULES AND REGULATIONS:**

- The governing rules of play shall be those set forth in the most current 2020
   United States Volleyball Official Rules publication, with any modifications decided upon by the tournament staff
- Any changes, additional rules, and/or modifications will be published in the tournament rules distributed at the Championships check in
- All questions, concerns, or protests shall be handled by the Championships
   Competition Committee, including rule changes
- We do NOT play tie-breaker matches at this event unless the Championships
   Committee feels necessary

#### OFFICIATING/SCOREKEEPING:

- The 2021 ASICS® Junior National Volleyball Championships is proud to have the support and cooperation of a strong core of certified volleyball officials/referees.
- As typical of most events, teams will be required to provide scorekeepers, lines judges, and R2 officials when assigned on the master schedule...Any team failing to fulfill their officiating duties when assigned will occur a \$100 fine, second offense in the event will be expulsion from the event
- All teams should be ready to play or officiate at the scheduled times. However, the tournament committee reserves the right to move matches up in time or to open courts, if necessary, to keep on schedule. We will make every attempt to not start a match earlier than scheduled unless the two teams competing agree to do so
- If COVID-19 protocols prohibit the usual lines judges, scorekeepers and R2 help needed on each match—we will modify this at the time we know what will be permitted

#### TOURNAMENT RESULTS:

- Coaches must check the posted score reports on AES immediately for accuracy
- A central location pod will answer all questions about format, results, etc.
- Any errors must be reported to the Results Pod immediately prior to the next round of play by the teams impacted by the error or the results stand

#### **OFFICIAL BALL:**

- Mikasa will provide the official volleyballs for the event.
- 12 and under age divisions will be utilizing the Lite version of Mikasa

#### AWARDS:

 The top four teams in each GOLD DIVISION will receive individual medals for the players and a team award

- All first-place consolation brackets will also receive individual medals for the
  players for winning their respective divisions -- we know how important every
  level of play is-not just the Gold Division-- so we are committed to awarding
  these to reward and recognize all our winning teams!)
- Coaches are to check the results center as to where to go to receive your medals if you win one---they will be awarded immediately after your championship match / or officiating responsibilities

#### **SPORTS MEDICINE:**

- A sports medicine team is provided and stationed in strategic areas of the venue for emergency care and preventative taping, etc.
- Clubs must bring their own supplies or purchase them from the Staff Trainers
- We highly recommend all teams carry a first aid kit with supplies/ICE IS ONLY SUPPLIED FOR INJURIES SUSTAINED DURING THE EVENT
- Navy Pier will also have certified paramedics, police, and Emergency ambulance service available for our event in case of an injury/accident that requires such care
- Coaches make sure to carry your medical releases and information

- Chicago Police Department will be assigned to the event
- The Chicago Fire Department monitors and patrols Navy Pier
- Certified EMS on duty in the Hall as well as Athletic Trainers














# COVID 19 UPDATE AS OF FEBRUARY 22, 2021

Please be aware that all participants and attendees MUST adhere to any and all restrictions if in effect during the June 11-15, 2021 ASICS JUNIOR NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS.

NOTE: Asics Jr National Championships will follow the most recent State and local requirements regarding COVID safety requirements pertaining to the facilities and equipment we use for the tournament. Such requirements may change frequently and we cannot predict with certainty what requirements may be in place at the time.
